

**Dental Council Regulation**  
**on**  
**Rules for Suspension or Cancellation of the License**  
**B.E.2538 (1995)**

---

With the agreement of the Special Prime Minister Council , the Dental Council upon the powers conferred by Article 23 (4) (l) and Article 27 upon the Dentists Act B.E. 2537 (1994) hereby issued Dental Council Regulation on rules for suspension or cancellation of the license as follow :

**Article 1.** The Dental Council Committee has the power to cancel the license for practising dentistry by the agreement of the Special Prime Minister Council on the following categories :

- (a) invalid membership of the Dental Council
- (b) unqualify according to Article 12 of Dentists Act B.E. 2537 (1994)
- (c) fit to the rule of Article 45 of Dentists Act B.E. 2537 (1994)

**Article 2.** The Dental Council Committee has the power to suspend or cancel the license with the agreement of Special Prime Minister Council in the case that the licensee found guilty in dental practice and had been punished according to the supreme judgement.

**Article 3.** The Dental Council Committee has the power to make a decision according to Article 43, paragraph 3 of the Dentists Act B.E.2537 (1994) in the case as follow :

- (1) the licensee did not keep up with dental etiquette as stated in the Dental Council Regulation on dental etiquette .
- (b) the licensee broke the Dental Council Regulation on limitation and agreement in practising dentistry.

This regulation has been issued in the Royal Government Gazette and validates a day after the date of issue.
